

Tribal STAR TRAINING FOR TRAINERS *SKILL-BUILDING TRAINING*

Learn about the Tribal STAR training model which includes:

- Culturally-enhanced facilitation and training skills;
- Leading to manage conversations that result in collaboration and ICWA compliance;
- Mediation and conflict resolution techniques that build productive relationships between tribal and non-tribal programs;
- Improving government-to-government relations.

This three-day event is devoted to improving local services for Tribal foster youth by providing training and skill building.

Day 1 is a full day of "Let The Spirit Lead: In the Best Interest of the Indian Child" ICWA training using the Tribal STAR Model. (Meant especially for those who have not previously attended a Tribal STAR ICWA training).

Day 2 you will learn the Tribal STAR model, training, facilitation, and mediation techniques. Participants will practice skills and form into teams that will provide training on Day 3.

Day 3 the teams formed on Day 2 will implement selected segments of a full ICWA training. Observers will provide feedback and a final discussion circle will close the day.

Tribal STAR is a program of the Academy for Professional Excellence, SDSU School of Social Work, and serves the counties of San Diego, Imperial, Riverside, San Bernardino, Orange, and Los Angeles (<u>http://theacademy.sdsu.edu</u>).
