Course Description: Every year approximately 300,000 children in the U.S. are at risk of sexual exploitation. As San Diego is a border city, local children are at a higher risk of being victims of human trafficking. This full day training will review risk factors for victims, predator recruitment strategies, and preventative actions that can be taken to support children, youth, and families in our community. Through experiential activities, videos, and case reviews, participants will have the opportunity to augment skills to work with survivors of commercial sexual exploitation.

This training may contain graphic language and content of a mature nature that may be disturbing to some participants.

Learning Objectives:

Upon completion of this course, participants will be able to:

- Recognize the signs that someone might be a victim or at risk of becoming a victim
- Identify effective intervention strategies
- Access resources available for youth and their families
- Address obstacles that impact intervention
