Course Description: What do you do when a child or adolescent says they are having suicidal thoughts? Do you have the tools to respond effectively? This half day training will provide participants with an opportunity to address difficult questions regarding suicidal ideation in youth and adolescents. Through interactive activities, participants will boost their suicide risk assessment skills and explore appropriate interventions. Participants will also discuss how to respond if a client commits suicide and implement a self-care plan.

- Ask direct questions about suicidal ideation and behaviors
- Identify proper conversation techniques to engage children & youth
- Use appropriate prevention & intervention techniques with children & youth
- Do a self-assessment and use self-care techniques as appropriate
