eLearning: Assessing Suicide Risk in Youth

DESCRIPTION:

The Children, Youth, and Families Division of Behavioral Health Services is supporting the safety component of the Live Well San Diego initiative by offering this training on Assessing Suicide Risk in Youth. Suicide is a significant problem among youth and the risk for suicide significantly increases with incarceration and isolation. This 1-hour eLearning course provides the tools to assist staff to recognize and assess suicide risk and to provide support, guidance, and intervention with youth and youth in detention.

AUDIENCE:

Juvenile detention staff, BHS family & support partners, therapists, counselors, case managers, and other direct service providers.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

Upon completion of this training participants will be able to:

- · Recognize signs of suicidal ideation in youth
- Identify proper conversation techniques
- List available tools to assess risk
- Identify intervention and prevention techniques
