COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This two part training series will focus on the newly revised Behavioral Health Assessment (BHA) for children ages 0-5. Day one is a full-day training and will provide background information and fundamental knowledge to complete an assessment using the new 0-5 BHA. Topics will include a review of typical and atypical developmental milestones, exploration of characteristics of the caregiver-child dyadic relationship, and diagnosis using the Diagnostic Classification of Mental Health and Developmental Disorders of Infancy and Early Childhood (DC: 0-3R). Day two is an experiential half-day training which focuses on the practice application of the material from day one.

AUDIENCE: CYF-BHS counselors, family and youth support partners, therapists, case managers, and other direct service providers working with children, youth, and families.

Upon completion of this training participants will be able to:

- Identify typical and atypical development milestones of the 0-5 population
- Assess for interdisciplinary needs of a young child and know how and when to refer out for supplemental services
- Identify characteristics of the caregiver-child dyadic relationship and how it impacts the focus of treatment
- Develop a diagnosis utilizing the DC: 0-3R
