Course Description: Motivational Interviewing (MI) is a person-centered, directive method for enhancing intrinsic motivation to change by exploring and resolving ambivalence. It is an evidence-based technique that is a collaborative, respectful, and guiding process of interaction with families and people receiving services. This is a process that focuses on resiliency and strengths. In this two session, 11-hour training, participants will learn the foundations of Motivational Interviewing and practice MI techniques.

Learning Objectives: Upon completion of this training, participants will be able to:

- Explain the principles and foundation of Motivational Interviewing
- Identify benefits of using MI with clients
- Apply MI principles and techniques in treatment
- Integrate MI techniques with current practice

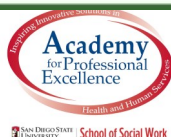
