Bullying has the potential for serious and lasting negative effects on mental health and overall well-being of children and youth. Everyone is effected—those who bully as well as those who are bullied. Effects of this systematic harassment range from feelings of hopelessness to an increased risk of suicidal ideation and behaviors. This half-day training will provide an examination of current trends in bullying, including cyber-bullying and explore best practices for interventions.
