Advanced Geriatric Mental Health Certificate Training

Course Description

Target Audience: For Introductory Geriatric Mental Health Certificate graduates and professionals currently serving older adults. All participants must be familiar with using CBT, DBT, MI, and WRAP prior to registration.

Course Description: This advanced, skills based training series will support community mental health, aging, primary care, and allied professionals on the biopsychosocial health related issues and risk factors of older adults and their families/caregivers. This series will provide participants with skills in engagement, assessment, trauma informed care, and interventions (including CBT, DBT, MI, and WRAP) specific to the older adult population.

Learning Objectives:

- ◆ Assess and determine treatment.
- ◆ Provide services in an appropriate culturally and spiritually consistent manner.
- ◆ Provide appropriate referrals and resources.
- ◆ Recognize the unique needs of older adults.
- ◆ Demonstrate treatment skills in at least three techniques used with older adults.
- ◆ Integrate a holistic approach of primary care and mental health.

This course meets the qualifications for 30 hours of continuing education credit for LMFTs, LCSWs, LPCCs, and/or LEPs as required by the California Board of Behavioral Sciences.
