

Tribal STAR TRAINING FOR TRAINERS SKILL-BUILDING TRAINING



Learn the Tribal STAR training model:

- Learn to manage conversations that result in collaboration and Indian Child Welfare Act (ICWA) compliance;
- Mediation and conflict resolution techniques that build productive relationships between tribal and non-tribal programs.

This three-day event is devoted to increasing capacity for successful implementation of the Core 3.0 full day ICWA training. It is for social workers, attorneys and court personnel, Tribal ICWA advocates and anyone interested in training ICWA.

Day 1 is the new Core 3.0 full day ICWA training "Working with Native American Families and Tribes". This training will be done using Tribal STAR training techniques, and integrates the new eLearning Indian Child Welfare Act (ICWA) Introduction. https://theacademy.sdsu.edu/elearning/icwa-elearning-core-3-0-icwa-intro/story.html

Day 2 will focus on enhancing skills in the areas determined to be most challenging by the group when implementing the new Core 3.2 ICWA training. Participants will practice skills and form into teams that will provide training on Day 3.

Day 3 the teams formed on Day 2 will implement selected segments of a full ICWA training. Observers will provide feedback and a final discussion circle will close the day.
