Announcing Medi-Cal Manual Third Edition

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) has now posted the Medi-Cal Manual Third Edition for Intensive Care Coordination (ICC), Intensive Home Based Services (IHBS) and Therapeutic Foster Care (TFC) Services for Medi-Cal Beneficiaries. This manual provides information and guidelines for the delivery and billing of ICC, IHBS, and the TFC service model.

These services continue to be available to all youth up to age 21 through the EPSDT benefit who are eligible for full scope Medi-Cal and meet medical necessity.

All previous mandates around the facilitation and timeline of CFT meetings organized by BHS providers for youth identified as Enhanced/Subclass remain in place.
