

Behavioral Health Education & Training Academy Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy Clinician Training

Description

Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT) offers a component-based, short-term treatment model. This treatment model is proven to be effective with children and youth. This treatment has been identified by BHS-CYF as one of the core treatment models to be used with children and youth seeking services.
