### COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Transitional Age Youth (TAY), generally defined as ages 16 - 25, are young adults that typically come from marginalized backgrounds. Their identity is shaped by their sex, gender, ethnicity, religious beliefs, health status, ability/disability, sexual orientation, gender identity, education level or income, and their geographical locations. TAY is a unique and dynamic population in need of services, like counseling, case management, supported housing, recreational opportunities, peer support, and independent living skills. This training will highlight the challenges that TAY experience and equip providers with best practices on how to work together to support TAY with these challenges.
