Milestones of Recovery Scale (MORS) is one of two options for required evidence based evaluation and outcomes measurement tool required by San Diego County Adult Behavioral Health Services. MORS tracks the process of recovery for individuals who live with mental health conditions. MORS is rooted in the principles of psychiatric rehabilitation and defines recovery as a process beyond symptom reduction, compliance and service utilization.
