What You Need To Know

All MASTER-NAPSA Certificate Program applicants are funded by a generous grant from California Department of Social Services (CDSS). All applications, documents, and questions should be directed to the MASTER-APS Training Program.

FY 2018-19 NAPSA Certificate Program Important Dates

Application Date: 01-JUL-17

All NAPSA applications should have the same date.

Look-back Date: 30-JUN-15

All training (eLearning & Instructor-led) must be completed *on or after* this date.

Employment Date: 01-MAR-17

Must have a minimum of 2 years as an APS professional by Submission Deadline.

NAPSA Certificate Submission: 01-MAR-19

DEADLINE for submitting *completed* training and application.

Simple Steps to Completing NAPSA Certificate Application

1. Register for NAPSA Certificate Program by submitting name via county training coordinator to MASTER-APS.
2. Submit 2-page application, training transcripts, and employment verification to MASTER-APS.
3. Complete all 23 Core Competency training courses.
4. Re-submit training transcripts/course completion documents to MASTER-APS for verification by 01-MAR-19.
