Course Description

Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT) is an evidence-based, culturally responsive treatment model for children and adolescents impacted by trauma and their parents or caregivers. This model addresses the unique needs of children and youth with PTSD symptoms, depression, or other behavioral, social, and emotional issues related to traumatic life experiences. After completing the in-classroom training, participants receive support through consultation calls to help identify and resolve challenges they may have when using TF-CBT with their current caseload. Course completion satisfies some criteria for TF-CBT Certification.
