In this interactive live webinar, participants will learn about the different types of high risk behaviors, how to identify and describe them objectively, and how to use screening methods. Participants will be encouraged to explore their own beliefs, attitudes, and other factors that can interfere with proper assessment and pattern recognition, and potentially increase the chance for risk. Through the use of case vignettes and examples, participants will gain a better understanding of evidence-based mitigation tools to increase safety when assessing an individual for both for self-harm and/or harm to others.

- Engage mitigation tools to increase individual safety when high-risk behavior is identified.
- Ensure intervention is culturally-competent, person-centered, and will not increase future risk-potential.
