Case management is a key component of service delivery. In this interactive, one-day training, participants will learn the fundamentals of case management including how to properly engage and assess for needs, address the whole person, and link to other services and levels of care with a warm hand-off. Additionally, participants will learn tools to coach a person receiving services on appropriate information sharing with various service providers including recovery residences, doctors, judges, etc. Finally, individuals will explore ways of navigating community resources to create a more integrated system of care for the individuals it serves.
