Course Description

Culture is a key factor linked to health disparities. The purpose of this training is for participants to gain a more in-depth understanding of health disparities in our current systems of care. Participants will examine their own cultural journey and gain awareness about how their own experiences influence their interactions with people receiving services, and their ability to deliver services. Training participants will examine their personal experiences with race and bias and have the opportunity to appreciate how culture, race and bias impacts people receiving services. In this full day virtual training, we will discuss ways to connect with people in a culturally appropriate manner to better serve their needs. Finally, participants will explore the role that organizations, institutions, and society plays in health disparities and ways of reducing these impacts on individuals.
