

APS Supervisor Coaching Pilot Program



Being a new APS Supervisor can be a complex, unique, and challenging experience! APSWI is introducing a special opportunity for new APS Supervisors to participate in a Supervisor Coaching Pilot Program designed to enhance knowledge, confidence, and develop value-based leadership skills.

What: APSWI will be offering its first ever APS Supervisor Coaching Pilot Program. The coaching program will provide both group and individual coaching sessions, and is designed to complement the APS Supervisor Core training deliveries which will include core competencies 1 through 4.

Supervisors will learn new information and enhance skills in the areas of Understanding Self as Supervisor, Diversity, Equity, & Inclusion (DEI), Supporting Team Building & Individual Development, and Case Consultation & Critical Thinking by completing pre-work, eLearnings, virtual instructor led training, and participating in follow up activities.

Participants in the coaching pilot program will have the opportunity to experience group and individual coaching that will allow them to explore and practice newly learned skills and behaviors, as well as support fellow participants in professional discovery and growth.

Who: This program will serve new APS Supervisors hired or promoted in April 2022 or after, in the following Southern California counties: San Diego, Imperial, Orange, Los Angeles, Riverside, and San Bernardino.

- Aug-Sept: Competency 1- Understanding Self as Supervisor
- Oct-Dec: Competency 2- Diversity, Equity and Inclusion/Transformation
- Jan-Mar: Competency 3-Supporting Team Building and Individual Development
- Apr-Jun: Competency 4- Case Consultation and Critical Thinking
